

EU Cosmetic Compliance Checklist:



Labeling & Packaging

(EC 1223/2009)



Interpret and apply EC 1223/2009 requirements, including latest amendments and related chemical regulations (REACH, CLP, POPs).



Confirm required symbols are present, correct, and legible (hourglass, PAO jar, “Refer to leaflet” icon).



Verify ingredient compliance — check for restricted/banned substances, assess safety data, flag nanomaterials, and confirm correct “nano” labelling.



Validate product claims (e.g., sustainability, allergen-free, hypoallergenic) are truthful, substantiated, and consistent across packaging and e-commerce.



Prepare and maintain the Product Information File (PIF), including Cosmetic Product Safety Report (CPSR) and manufacturing method (GMP).



Maintain brand integrity while meeting regulatory content and formatting rules.



Complete CPNP notification before placing products on the EU market.



Check print and packaging accuracy — artwork matches approved content, colours and legibility are correct, and no information is missing.



Ensure accurate and compliant label content — product name, Responsible Person details, country of origin, nominal content, durability/PAO, precautions, batch number, function, and ingredient list in correct order.



Coordinate across teams to ensure updates (e.g., formula change, label translation, regulatory amendment) are implemented consistently across all markets.
